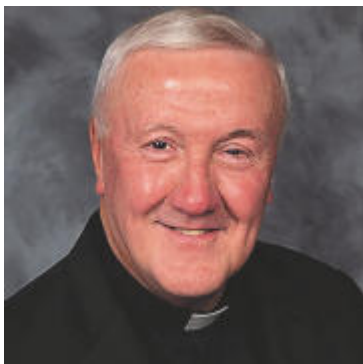

A Letter From our Administrator



Dear Parishioners,

This week we enter the **Holiest Week of the Year** – a week that begins and ends in triumph and rejoicing. It is the most important week of the Christian calendar. We walk through the events of Jesus' life that brought us salvation. I encourage all of us to participate in the Holy Week Liturgies that make this week the center of our faith. Our Holy Week services will be abbreviated this year because of the pandemic guidelines (e.g. Washing of the Feet, our processions on Palm Sunday and the Easter Vigil will be omitted). But we are grateful that we can celebrate them in church, which is a huge step forward from last year when churches were closed. **The Holy Week Services along with the 9 am Mass on Easter Sunday will be livestreamed on St. Mary's Facebook page.**

Lent ends on Holy Thursday night as we begin the days called the Triduum (three days) keeping the observances of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Vigil/Sunday. While Lent ends on Holy Thursday night, our spiritual path leads us ever more deeply into the exercise of keeping the Triduum to mark our faith life with Jesus own life, as told in the Scriptures of those days: The Institution of the Eucharist on Holy Thursday, the Passion account on Good Friday, and the readings of the Vigil and Easter Sunday, tell of our being baptized into the death and resurrected life of Christ Jesus.

Please give special attention to the schedule for all of our Holy Week services on page 5 of this bulletin. Participating in our Holy Week services is a fitting way to conclude our Season of Lent. Beginning with the new fire, the Easter Vigil recounts all of salvation history culminating in baptism and the renewal of our Baptismal promises.

Our Liturgy committee, liturgical ministers, choir and musicians and those who decorate church are working hard to prepare for the Sacred Triduum. We want to thank them for the generosity of their time and talent.

Along with the priests and deacons of our Diocese, Deacon Danny Roussel and myself will participate in the **Chrism Mass** on Tuesday, March 30. So there will no noon Mass at St. Mary's on Tuesday, March 30th. At the Chrism Mass, Bishop Duca blesses the Oils of Chrism, Catechumens, and the Sick, which are then sent to every church parish for their celebrations of the Sacraments during the coming year. Because of the larger seating capacity, the Chrism Mass this year will be celebrated at St. George Church.

Please keep our 12 RCIA elect and candidates in your special prayers this week. At the Easter Vigil on Saturday evening, they will be celebrating the Sacraments of Initiation (i.e. Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation).

May God especially bless us during this holy time of year. Please continue to pray for one another and our family of faith.

Walk Every Step with Christ

Holy Week is a week for being mindful. We must set loose the baggage of Lent, and not be deterred by the dazzling sunrise of Easter morning beckoning in the distance.

It's okay for us to be excited for Easter. We've waited so long, after all. In my opinion it's one of the best feelings there is: the yearning we have in our hearts for the Resurrection as we embark on Palm Sunday. And in a purely logical sense, many of us have Easter celebrations for which we are preparing, and practical considerations to contend with. It's going to be a busy week, one likely full of happy distractions.

But my friends, we simply must keep our feet on the ground. Let's not "skip" Holy Week. Resist the urge to flip to the last page of the book, to fast-forward to the final scene of the movie. Don't rob yourself of the journey. This week is a blessed opportunity. It is this week that teaches us who we are. In the span of the Triduum, we have the birthday of the priesthood, the institution of the Eucharist, the sacrifice on Calvary and so many other vivid and meaningful scenes.

It may sound strange, to advise someone to savor the moments of Holy Week. There are so many violent and heartrending moments, after all. But this is the valley of tears, remember — we are not in Heaven yet. And here, in our fallen, sin-filled world, it is the heartrending moments that seem to matter the most.

These are the moments that define us as Catholics. Live them. Cherish them. Be present for each one.
