What? This is our third year participating in the #iGIVECATHOLIC annual fundraising program. It has been a great success for our parish in the past two years. This year, we are focusing on renovating the kitchen of our Parish Hall, which is Phase 2 of the total project.

Why? The Parish Hall is 40 years old and has never been updated. It is the main activity building on our church campus. We have already begun Phase 1 of the project which includes the social gathering area, restrooms and side rooms.

Cost? We anticipate the total cost to be approximately \$150,000 but we are working VERY hard to keep it below this. This project will be funded with our Building Fund Savings and General Operating Funds. Any amount that you contribute will reduce the funds needed from our General Operating Funds.

Goal? \$35,000 to help fund Phase 2 of this project.

When? The early giving period began on Monday, November 18 and goes through Monday, December 2, with Giving Tuesday on December 3.

How? Giving is easy. Simply visit our website at www.stmarysfr.org and click on the green 'iGiveCatholic donate button'. If you don't have access to a computer, you are invited to contribute by check and make payable to St. Mary and put a notation in the memo section "iGiveCatholic".
